**Re: Regular Action Pistol Match Scheduled for September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2008**

Next month (September) will be the BACKUP GUN MATCH:

The Backup Gun Match will give the competitor an opportunity to engage targets with a small backup pistol as well as their regular sidearm; the overall dimensions are extremely limited and must fit in a box that will be at the match. The box dimensions are 1.375" deep X 5.00" tall X 6.750" wide. Most 5-shot revolvers (S&W Chief's Special, etc.) and some semi-autos (i.e. Walther PPK/clones, SIG P230, Kel-Tec .380, the Springfield XD9/XD40 subcompacts and *some* mini-Glocks) qualify. If you have Pierce grip (or clone) extensions on your mags they will not fit in the box. If you do not have such a pistol a loaner (and ammo) will be provided per CRPC rules; see the CRPC Action Pistol website for more details. There are no caliber restrictions at this match, but it is advisable to have a backup gun that holds at least 5 rounds.

**I would ask that if you do not have a BUG you please donate to cover the cost of .38 Special ammo.**

I would appreciate it if you notify me ASAP if you are attending and DO NOT have a suitable pistol; this allows us to plan accordingly.

BRING YOUR BACKUP GUN AND 50 ROUNDS OF AMMO (IN ADDITION TO YOUR REGULAR SIDEARM AND AMMO). *YOU WILL BE SHOOTING YOUR BACKUP GUN IN AT LEAST THREE STAGES, AND **MAY** HAVE TO USE YOUR REGULAR SIDEARM IN AT LEAST TWO STAGES AS WELL...*
